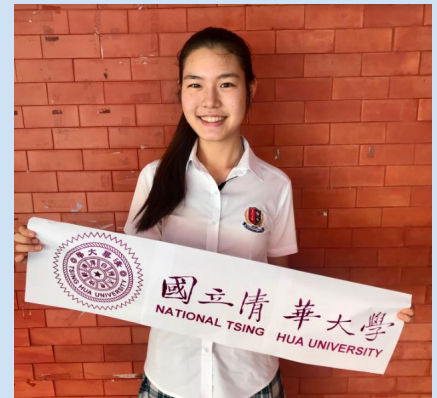
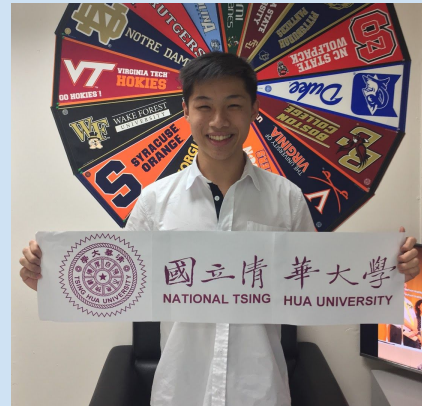

was accepted to University of Iowa in the USA for the Neuroscience Program!

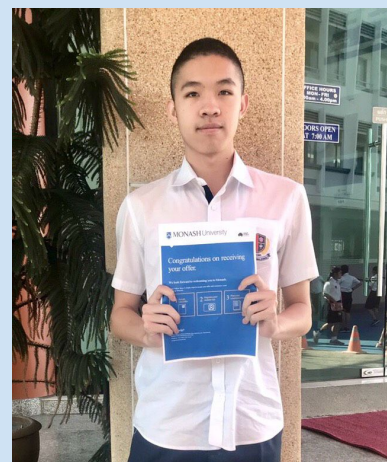

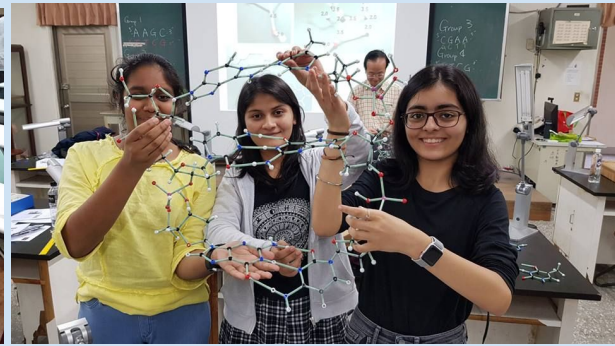
was Accepted to Monash University, Australia, in the Engineering Program.

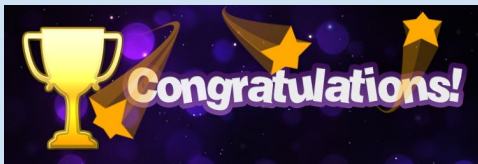

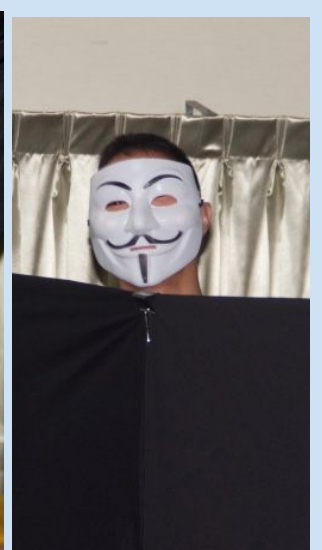
