


THAI-CHINESE INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL

HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE 2024-2025

Thai-Chinese International School (TCIS) is a private, non-profit, coed, day school founded in 1995 to provide an English language-based education for the Taiwanese community of Bangkok, as well as the Thai and other international communities. The school curriculum is an extension of progressive American standardsbased programs that have been adapted to meet the expectations of the Taiwanese and Thai school community. Mandarin courses are taught with an emphasis on history and culture. English is the medium of instruction in all courses other than Thai, Mandarin, and other foreign languages. Thai students take both Mandarin and Thai language classes.

Total enrollment (PreK-12) this year is 630 students. There are 189 students in the high school (9-12) including a Senior Class of 37 students.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

There are 180 school days divided into 2 semesters. The first semester is in session from August 6, 2024 through January 15, 2025. The second semester runs from January 16 to June 12, 2025 (June 6, 2025 for seniors). We have a block schedule which meets for four 80-minute periods of instruction each day. Most students take 8 classes each semester, although qualifying students may be permitted to take a not-for-credit Independent Study class.






