Please join the Buddhist ceremony in the morning by offering dried and canned food to the monks. **Students are encouraged to wear a Thai Northeast traditional dress.** Appropriate dress for male students includes a Songkran floral printed shirt, school pants and pa kao ma. Appropriate attire for female students includes Thai blouse and Thai skirt.

If your child would like to participate in the water splashing, please have them bring a dark color T-shirt and pants to wear during the activity. Students may bring a container of water about the size of their hand or a small bottle to use while they are playing with the water. <u>All water guns are prohibited.</u> After the water playing, the students will wear their regional Thai costume, Songkran T-shirt, or school uniform.

In addition, students will be manning booths promoting Thai culture. The profits from the booths will go to a Thai charity and future events.
