News from the Middle School Counselor



Hello Middle School Parents!

With Winter break just around the corner, it's important to remind students to do their best to finish the semester strong. Though it may be tempting, now is not a time to take it easy and begin to slack off. The break will be so much sweeter if the student knows they did their best right up until the end, and then they can take time over break to rest, relax, spend time with family and friends, and yes, probably play a few video games too! Below are a few tips for parents to help your child stay on track before break.

1) Continue checking your child's Google Classroom for each class. Teachers continually post assignments and other valuable information there. By looking at this with your child, it will not only help you stay on top of what is going on inside of their classrooms, but it will also help them get into the habit of doing this on their own each day.

2) Make sure your child is getting enough rest each night. Middle School aged students should be getting at least 9 hours of sleep each night. If that isn't the case, talk with your child about their daily routine. Find out when they start and finish their homework. Check to see if they're taking a break from technology before bed. Keeping an eye on a phone screen right before bed makes it much more difficult to fall asleep.

3) Continue checking the TCIS Facebook page, Line Group, and website for the most up to date information about activities going around campus. There may be a concert, ceremony, Talent Show, or another event you want to check out before break. Encourage your children to get involved in these types of events. The more involved a student is in school, the more invested they are. This will hopefully lead to success in the classroom as well!

4) Remind them that the semester isn't over yet! They still have time to make-up work for certain classes if their teacher has given them the opportunity to do so. This can boost their grades right before break.

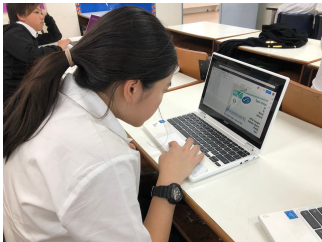


Grade 5 & 6

Grades 5 ended their spreadsheet unit by completing assignments of calculating averages and creating a simple budget. They are currently working on building their keyboarding skills as well as learning the basics of block coding.
