News from the Middle School Counselor



Hello Middle School Parents!

I hope you had a wonderful break with your families and were able to step away from school for a few weeks to relax and enjoy each other's company! With the 2nd semester under way, I wanted to give some quick tips that can lead to a great start to the new semester.

- 1) Think about what went right during the first semester. Was your child completing all of their assigned homework each day? Were they prepared for every class each day? Were they getting enough sleep at home? Was their behavior in the classroom positive? If so, great! Continue these positive behavior traits throughout this next semester.
- 2) Readdress goals that were set at the beginning of the year. Was your child able to reach their goals for a given class? Were they able to meet their social, athletic, or musical goals? Take a moment to review

previously set goals, and then think about setting new **SMART** goals for the second semester.

- 3) Make sure homework is complete before every class and prepare for upcoming exams. While homework is usually a small portion of a student's overall grade in a class, getting in the habit of completing homework each day not only helps a student build necessary skills in that class, but it also helps them learn how to be more responsible overall.
- 4) Look at your child's 1st semester report card with them. Try to understand how your child earned the grade they did. If it wasn't what you or they were expecting, or if it wasn't to your satisfaction, was it because of a lack of preparation for exams? Were they not focused during class time? Did they not complete homework? Were they having trouble working well in groups? By breaking each grade down into categories like homework, exam grades, projects, etc. you can learn which areas to focus on during this next semester.
- 5) Work on time management and organization. Do you look through Google Classroom with your child each day to see what they're working on? Does your child have folders or another system to organize their class materials? Is their computer working properly? Review this with your child to make sure they've crossed their t's and dotted their i's.
- 6) Have your child get involved in extracurricular activities. Whether it's joining a sports team, a club at TCIS, playing music, volunteering, or something else altogether, find an activity that your child likes and encourage them to do it after school or on weekends. Academics are important, but so is learning or practicing a new skill or getting to know other kids through activities outside of school.
- 7) Look into your child's support system. Where do they go when they need help? Who do they talk to? Are they asking for help at home? Are they talking to their teachers or counselor? Do they have trusting friends? Making sure your child has a rock solid support system will help them tremendously in school and out.

If there's anything I can do to better support your child at school, please let me know. I am happy to meet with you any time. My door is always open. Welcome back again, and have a great second semester!!


Dear Parents,


