Welcome back from October Break! Breaks are a great time to step away from the stressors of school, spend time with friends and family, or just rest up and recharge your batteries. We hope you and you children were able to take a break from school and enjoy some time together. Now that we're back, it's time to get laser focused for the 2nd Quarter. Here are some tips you can try at home to ensure a successful 2nd quarter:

1) Time management skills are learned. To help them with this, keep an eye on your child's routine. When do they get home? When do they start/finish their homework? What time are they eating dinner or going to bed? What time do they wake up for school to ensure they're here on time for their first class

(7:30am)? By helping students better manage their time, they will learn this necessary skill which will help them in school and out.

- 2) Put yourself in their shoes. As a counselor, I have often spoken to students about empathy, the ability to feel how other people are feeling. Take a moment to truly understand how your child is doing in school, from their perspective. How are their classes going? How are their relationships with their friends? Open up a dialogue with them about these and other topics, and allow them to share how they're feeling from their perspective. You will learn a lot about them, and it will allow them to feel heard.
 3) Trust their teachers. Remember the teachers are your partners in your child's journey. They are there to help, both academically and socially. Everyone (teachers, parents, administrators) wants what's best for your child. Have conversations with teachers if there are aspects of your child's learning that you are

Dear Parents,

It is my pleasure to inform you of the progress we have made in Physical Education throughout the first quarter. We began the year with a unit on fitness which culminated in the Fitness Graham pre-test. Several times throughout the year we will re-test to check on the gains students are making in developing cardiovascular endurance, muscular endurance, and muscular strength. In grade 5 we also completed a unit developing skills for throwing, catching, and striking with long handled implements and applying those to the game of T-ball. For the month of October, the students are working on developing their swimming skills with Ms. Print and Ms. Sam. In grade 6, students also worked on developing the same skills but have applied those skills to the sport of Softball, where they are striking a moving target rather than a stationary ball which sits upon a Tee. In grades 7 & 8, Mr. Brad and myself have divided the classes into boys and girls' classes to focus on individual skill

development and providing more opportunities for each student to build confidence in themselves and their skill attainment. Both classes have worked on the same skills as the other grades, but their activities are quite different from the lower grades. After the fitness unit, both classes completed a striking unit and applied their skills in both softball and floor hockey. For the month of October, they are spending half of month working on swimming skills and outdoor invasion games with a focus on American Football.

In grades 6-8, students also completed written tests that measure their skill knowledge, and knowledge of both hockey and softball. These tests only measured what was taught in class and every student was sent a study guide two weeks before the test in Google Classroom. Throughout the year we will continue to have written and/or skills tests to assess student learning in addition to daily participation points which accrue daily. Participation scores still account for 60% of a student's grade, whereas written and skill assessments account for the remaining 40%.















