This has been a busy week in the lower school!



Wednesday PK4 went on our first field trip of the year to Ocean World. It was a really fun learning experience for them.


Today we had a wonderful celebration for Double Ten Day. We did not let the rain get us down this morning. The students listened and waved their flags. This marks the official end to quarter one.
