**Professional Bio:**

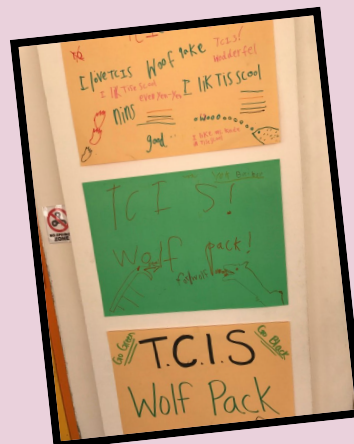
