Thai-Chinese International School (TCIS) is a private, non-profit, co-ed, day school founded in 1995 to provide an English language-based education for the Taiwanese community of Bangkok, as well as the Thai and other international communities. The school curriculum is an extension of progressive American standards-based programs that have been adapted to meet the expectations of the Taiwanese and Thai school community. Mandarin courses are taught with an emphasis on history and culture. English is the medium of instruction in all courses other than Thai, Mandarin, and other foreign languages. Thai students take both Mandarin and Thai language classes.

Total enrollment (K-12) this year is 578 students. 75% are ethnic Thai, 15% Taiwanese, and 10% other. There are 168 students in the high school (9-12) including a Senior Class of 47 students.

The school has an eclectic international faculty with 73 fully qualified teachers (38 with Master's Degrees and 4 with PhD's) from 10 countries. The largest numbers coming from the United States, Canada, Thailand, and Taiwan. Other countries represented by our staff include Myanmar, the Philippines, Japan, Sri Lanka, Spain, and the United Kingdom.

TCIS is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC), the Thai Ministry of Education, and the Ministry of Education of the Republic of China. TCIS is also a member of the East Asia Regional Council of Overseas Schools (EARCOS).

There are 180 school days divided into 2 semesters. The first semester is in session from August 29 through February 3, 2023. The second semester runs from February 6 to June 22, 2023 (June 16, 2023 for seniors). We have a block schedule which meets for four 90 minute periods of instruction each day. Most students take 8 classes each semester, though some are permitted to take a non-credited Independent Study class.
