Update regarding quarantine guidelines

Test Positive for Covid

• When students/staff Positive result on ATK he/she must be getting RT-PCR

- or Rapid antigen test to confirm the result from the hospital.
 - Hospital Partner of TCIS is Chularat 3 International Hospital

no cost for Thai nationality with Rapid antigen test only

Source of information: Chularat 3 International Hospital informs the school.

- Quarantine Period according the doctor considers.
- When recovered students/staff must share a Medical Certificate with the school nurse before returning to campus and also present the negative result on ATK

High Risk Group

- People in close contact with a person that tests positive for COVID-19
- Talking closely for more than five minutes without a surgical mask
- The air in the place is not ventilated and you are within 1 metre of the infected person for more than 5 mins.
- Live in the same house

Protocol

- You must quarantine for **10 days** and take ATK tests then report the results to nurse@tcis.ac.th
- The ATK tests should be taken on Day 0, Day 5 and Day 10. You can return to campus with the negative ATK result after 10 days.

Closed Classroom (According to The Samutprakarn MOPH and MOE guidelines)

- **One case** : Closed classroom for three days and deep cleaning
- **Two case and more (with the same event)** : Teachers, TA, and students in the class must quarantine at home for 10 days and take the ATK test on the days that are requested by the school nurse.
